## **ORDINANCE NO. 1048**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MAIZE, KANSAS, AMENDING SECTION 11-208 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MAIZE, KANSAS, PERTAINING TO PROHIBITING LOUD AND UNNECESSARY NOISE, AND REPEALING THE ORIGINAL SECTION 11-208 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MAIZE, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING B ODY OF THE CITY OF MAIZE, KANSAS:

Section 1. <u>Section 11-208 of the Code Amended</u>. Section 11-208 of the Code of the City of Maize, Kansas, is amended to read:

## 11-208. Loud and unnecessary noise.

It is unlawful for any person to make, continue or allow to be made or continued any excessive, unnecessary, recurrent or loud noise which creates a nuisance or injures or endangers the comfort, repose, health or safety of others, or which interferes with the use or enjoyment of property of any person of reasonable sensibilities residing in or occupying the area unless the making and continuing of such noise is necessary for the protection and preservation of property or the health and safety of some individual. (*See Wichita v. Smith*, 31 Kan.App.2d 837).

Making loud and unnecessary noise is a Class C violation.

Section 2. Repeal. The existing Section 11-208 of the Code of the City is repealed.

**Section 3.** Publication. This ordinance takes effect upon the publication of a summary of this ordinance once in the *Clarion*, the official city newspaper.
